March 12-14, 2024

ParlAmericas Delegation to Washington will consist of a series of meetings with OAS officials, US Congress representatives, and Washington-based partners. The format will include bilateral meetings, round table dialogue and a series of committee hearing-style dialogues with representatives from the different OAS Secretariats. Included in the program is a Special Meeting with the OAS Committee on Juridical and Political Affairs (CAJP) to respond to the OAS General Assembly Resolution AG/RES. 3004 (LIII-O/23) STRENGTHENING DEMOCRACY<sup>1</sup>

## **General Objectives:**

- Continue strengthening institutional relations between the OAS and ParlAmericas
- Identify inputs and reflections on the design and implementation for enhanced parliamentary engagement at the OAS through ParlAmericas;
- Inform parliamentarians about the work of the OAS and discuss issues of shared interest being prioritized in its work: regional security and transnational crime, democracy and the rule of law, gender equality and human rights, migration, climate change, and economic development, among others;
- Foster connections with the US Congress;
- Inform ParlAmericas' 2024-2030 strategic plan.
