#### Panel: The socio-economic benefits of ending plastic pollution

The panel will present on the resolution to develop a Global Plastics Treaty, and the opportunity it provides to respond collaboratively to the urgency to end plastic waste. It will also help bring understanding of the roles, responsibilities and location of women of different racial and ethnic groups as workers and agents of change for reducing plastic consumption. Moreover, the panel will examine how parliaments can create and/or modify legal frameworks to reduce plastics and ensure it equitably benefits everyone.
