Visas:

All travelers must have a valid passport and, in certain cases, it is required to obtain a <u>visa to enter Paraguay</u>. Participants are responsible for confirming with the consular authorities of their respective countries in regard to applicable documents required to enter Paraguay and any other country through which they will transit. Health Insurance:

All participants are advised to obtain health insurance.

Currency:

The national currency of Paraguay is the *Guaraní* and is represented by PYG. Foreign currency can be exchanged at most banks and exchange offices located at the airport and in most shopping malls. The official exchange rate is approximately \$7313 PYG per \$1 USD (US dollar).

Electricity:

The standard electricity voltagein Paraguay is 220 volts. In Paraguay, type C plugs and sockets are used.

Yellow Fever Vaccine:

It is recommended to verify with the health authorities of your country whether you require the yellow fever vaccine for travel to or from Paraguay.

Food Restrictions:
