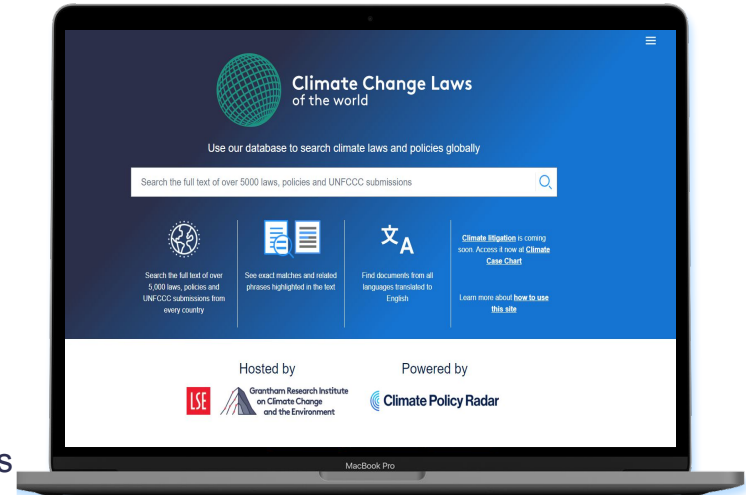

1. Fruto de la colaboración entre el Grantham Research Institute y GLOBE International en una serie de estudios sobre legislación climática.
2. Desde 2023, funciona con tecnología de aprendizaje automático y procesamiento del lenguaje natural desarrollada por Climate Policy Radar (CPR).
3. Juntos, CPR y GRI mantienen y actualizan lo que actualmente es el recurso mundial más completo sobre legislación y política climática, con más de 5.000 leyes, políticas y propuestas de la CMNUCC de todos los países.

Constitution of Tuvalu 2023

Tuvalu's Constitution was updated in 2023 to contain provisions that reaffirm Tuvalu's statehood in perpetuity. It also commits the government of Tuvalu to responding to climate change, which poses threats to the country's future.

Federal Climate Adaptation Act (KAnG)

The Federal Climate Adaptation Act is Germany's (separate) climate framework law aimed at strengthening society, the economy and infrastructure as well as nature and ecosystems. Pursuant to the law, the government will develop a climate adaptation strategy with measurable targets by the end of September 2023. The ...

In this respect, gender equality policy impacts should be taken into account when creating climate adaptation strategies. With its framework, the present draft law creates a basis for appropriate strategies and concepts that have a positive impact on gender equality against the background of climate change. This law is not expected to have any impact on demographic change.

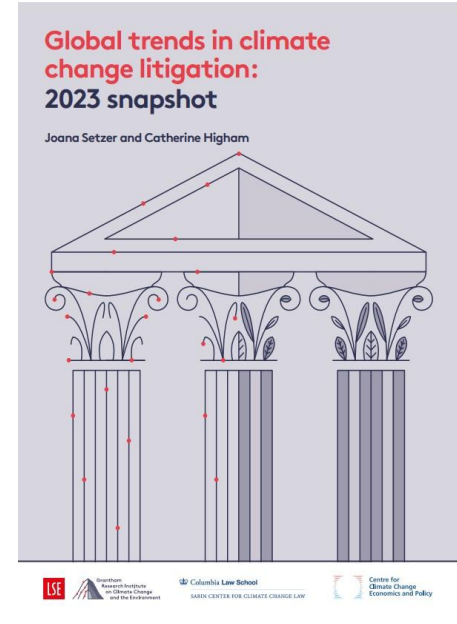
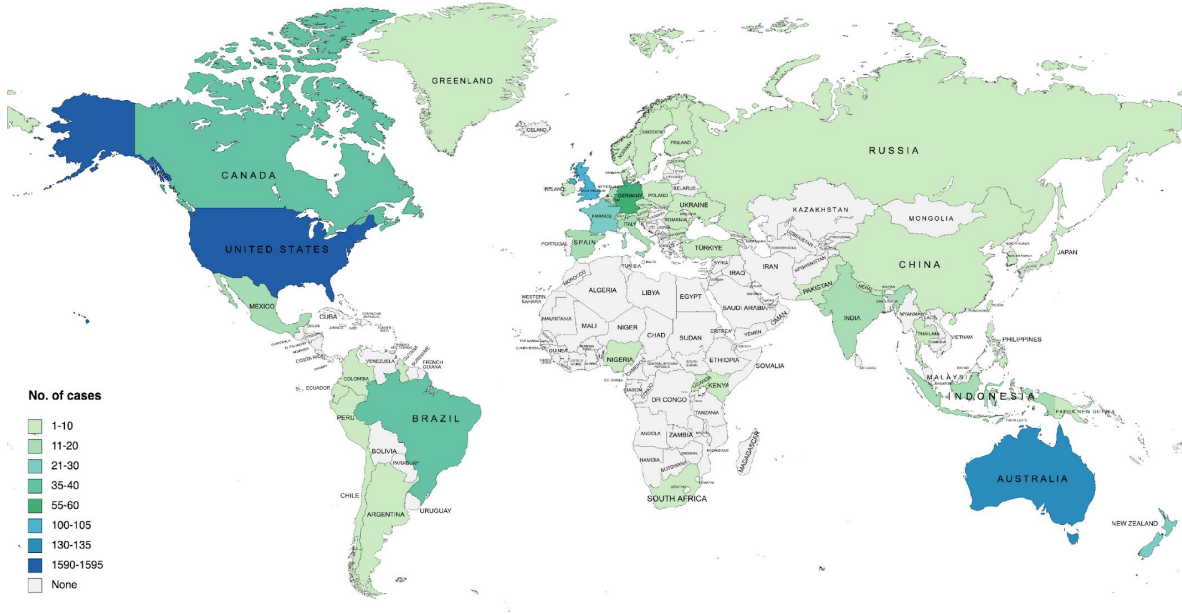

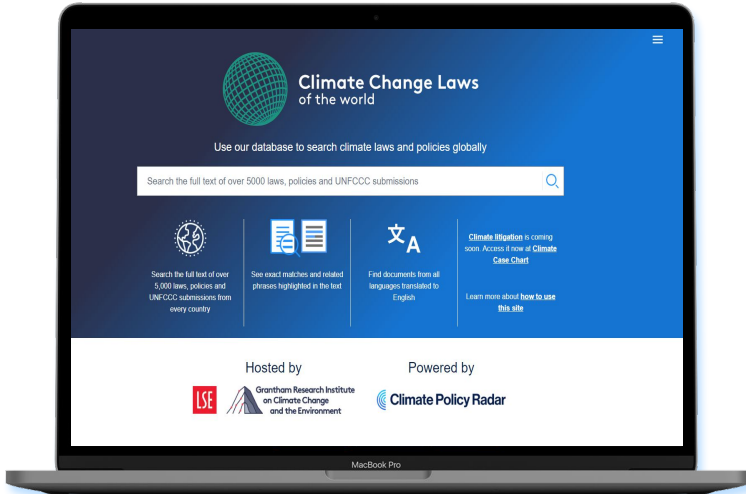
