¿Qué es el PGAI?

- It is a planning instrument based on the methodological principles of an Environmental Management System (PGAI in Spanish). It is based on an environmental diagnosis of institutional activities that considers all environmental aspects inherent to the organization, including those related to energy efficiency, fuels, waste, water and climate change, among other environmental aspects. Based on this diagnosis, measures are established to prevent, mitigate, compensate or restore environmental impacts, whether in the short, medium or long term.
- A PGAI is based on a cyclical process of planning, implementation, review and improvement of the procedures and actions carried out by an institution to ensure compliance with its environmental objectives.




